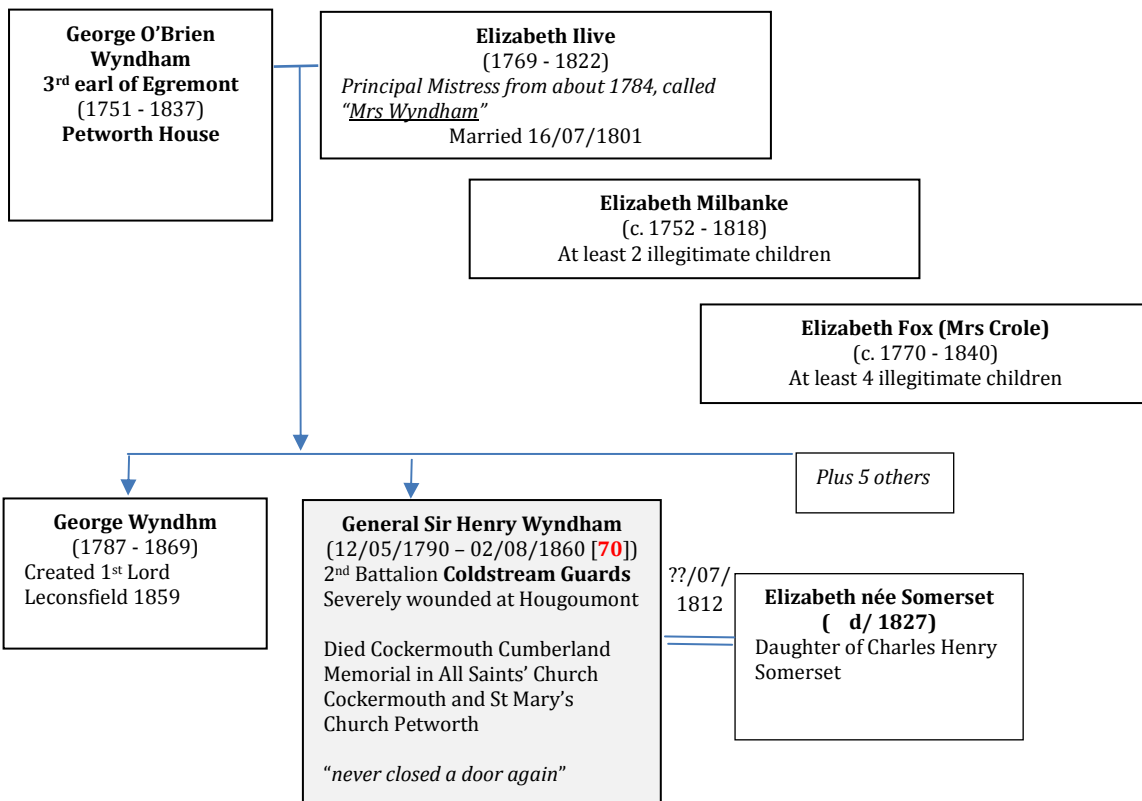
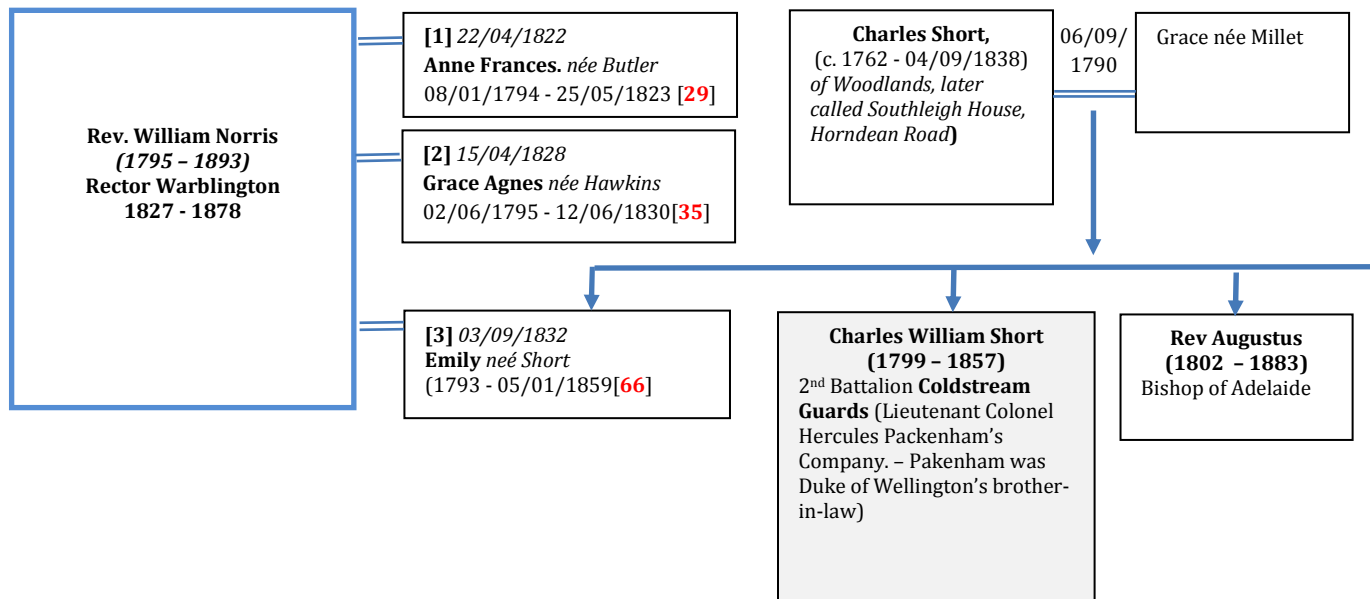


Defence of Hougoumont



Note: Coldstream Guards, originally Monck's Regiment of Foot, formed 1650 as part of Cromwell's model army. Coldstream is on the north bank of the River Tweed (in Scotland) 15 miles from Berwick on Tweed and 10 from Kelso. George Monck (1608 - 1670) used Coldstream as a base for his regiment before returning to England in support of the restoration of Charles II.
