b. INCOME

Income from subscriptions has not yet reached the forecast budget for the year. £10 of this is due to the members who have underpaid. Income is likely to increase due to additional memberships over the course of the year, but numbers are difficult to forecast. Based on previous years, the forecast for the year should be achieved.

c. **EXPENDITURE**

Expenditure to the end of June was approximately £960 less than expected. The majority of this was due to late invoicing for hall rents. Expenditure on speakers was less than the budget for the quarter, due to talks being given by u3a members. However, charges made by speakers can vary widely, so the forecast for the year has not been changed.

d. FORECAST FOR THE YEAR

A deficit of £470 is currently forecast for this year. General reserves would be sufficient to cover this. However, it is early in the year and further changes to the forecast are likely to occur.

5. Membership Report:

- a. 516 Members, 2 members still owe £5. Tim had emailed the 2 members but has had no response therefore to join next year the £5 owing will be added to 2024/2025 subscription.
- b. It was suggested that consideration should be given to using BEACON for subscription renewals. Action: Karen and Sue to investigate
