#### What does it cost?

At present, the annual subscription is £18 per member per year, payable on 1 September each year, but this may rise if costs increase. The only other costs depend on which subject groups you take part in: there may be books or learning materials required, entry charges to exhibitions, theatre tickets, or the shared cost for a meeting venue.

Group concessionary rates are often obtained, making entry to many exhibitions open to the public much cheaper than individual entry.


#### **GENERAL MONTHLY MEETINGS**
