

AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION 10 MAY 2018

Introduction

The current constitution of Exmouth and District U3A was signed on the 9 May 2013. This contained Clause 3 concerning charitable purposes. The Third Age Trust in consultation with the Charity Commissioners have now agreed a revised standard charitable purposes clause which will be applicable to all U3As

At the AGM on the 10 May 2018, the Exmouth and District U3A considered this proposal and it was agreed to replace the existing clause with the new one.

Existing Clause 3 - Charitable Purposes

'to advance education and wellbeing, in particular the education and wellbeing of people not in full time gainful employment who are in their Third Age (being the period of time after the first age of childhood dependence and the second age of full time employment and/or parental responsibility) residing in Exmouth and its surrounding locality'.

Replacement Clause 3 - Charitable Purposes

'the advancement of education and, in particular, the education of older people and those who are retired from full time work by all means, including associated activities conducive to learning and personal development, residing in Exmouth and its surrounding area'.

Decision at AGM on 10 May 2018.

The members voted unanimously in favour of the new charitable purposes clause which would be adopted forthwith. This decision was formally recorded in the minutes.
