Publicity relating to outside bodies

- 1. Exmouth and District U3A (the U3A) is always pleased to publicise the activities and celebrate the achievements of its members relevant to the founding principles of the U3A movement.
- 2. However, it is the general policy of the U3A not to publicise, advertise or otherwise endorse activities or services brought to its attention by outside bodies. In particular, it does not circulate details to its members of any such activities or services that might be offered. Neither does it accept flyers, posters or other materials for display at its meetings or events.
- 3. Speakers at U3A meetings may bring promotional material with them that has relevance to the talk they are intending to give. This permission is limited to the day of the talk only. Where there is a charitable purpose to the organisation represented by a speaker, a financial collection for the benefit of the charity will be acceptable provided that no pressure is put upon members of the U3A to contribute.
- 4. Members of the U3A may bring promotional material to meetings of the U3A provided that this relates directly to the activities of outside bodies with which they are personally involved. Any such material shall be capable of being displayed discreetly and passively on a side table.
