
FIFE u3a MEMBERS' DAY - THURSDAY 8 JUNE 2023


The answer which received the most votes is marked in red.






Q1 - For Art Appreciation, which of these 3 is your favourite painting?

- **C. Urban Landscape** The Grand Canal at the Church of La Salute- Canaletto (1727)




Q2 - From Theatre and Film, which is your favourite acting couple?


