A small group of members joined me for a walk through the Lydney Estates. We had some good views along the way across the River Severn to the Cotswolds and as we returned into Lydney we had some good views looking across the town towards St Mary's Church.

The walk on the 15 June will start from the Swan Road car Park at 10.00. Along the 6 mile route we will pass some historical structures. On arrival at the harbour there is the chance to have some refreshment with a break to allow time to explore the harbour before returning to the start via Lydney golf club.

The walk on the 20 Jul will start from Parkend Sports Field, opposite the Memorial Hall at 10:00. We will have a 5 mile circular route that will allow us the chance to visit Cannop Ponds before any construction work is started.

August 17: Stan Bosher will be leading Abbots Wood/ Soudley Ponds Walk

The starting point will be the children's play ground at the end of Buckshaft Road that is a turning off St Whites Rd which is the road to Coleford bypassing Cinderford. There is parking in this area.

The walk will enter Abbots Wood and climb the gentle slope towards the crest of the ridge. Over the top and down to the track towards the stables. Turning right off the track winding down to the lower track. Right onto the lower track climbing up to the path on the left which leads down to the Littledean Road. Crossing the road into Soudley Ponds car park and after the car park descending to go over the bridge to walk down the right side of the valley At the end of the ponds climb up the path towards Abbots Wood. Enter the wood and immediately take the path on the left. Going along the path until it meets the rising path which leads to the track that heads back to the starting point.
