

## Turn your iPhone or iPad into a magnifier.

Apple iPhones and iPads have a built in Magnifier tool that uses the camera on your device to zoom in on hard-to-read print in newspapers, magazines, or books.

You first need to enable the feature,

Tap the Settings icon, then tap General> Accessibility> Magnifier and switch on Magnifier in this section.

To activate the magnifier press the Home button **(1)** three times (fairly rapidly).

Tap the lightning icon **(2)** to switch on the torch.

The - to + slider **(3)** increases or reduces the size of the text you are reading.

If you find it difficult to keep your hand steady when reading the magnified text tap the lock icon or the big white button **(4)** on the screen (this depends on which device you are using,) this freezes the print you are looking at, tap again to release.

The icon with three coloured circles **(5)** takes you to the screen to adjust the brightness and contrast.

Icon **(6)** inverts the colours.

Sliders **(7)** & **(8)** adjust brightness and contrast.

The tabs above the sliders **(9)** (None, White/Blue, Yellow/Blue etc.) adds different filters which may help you view some items better.

Press the Home button to return to normal.
