### MEMBERSHIP FEES

The membership year of Forest Town & District U3A runs from **1<sup>st</sup>. April to 31<sup>st</sup>. March.**

The fees for the Membership year April 2020 to March 2021 are as follows:

Single annual membership is **£17.00** This includes a £3.50 Capitation fee to our National Organisation, *The Third Age Trust*, which provides a wide range of services and benefits, including liability insurance cover.

If you belong to another U3A, the annual membership fee is reduced by the amount of the Capitation Fee to **£13.50**. Please supply proof of U3A membership. **N.B. This only applies to full year membership.**

If you are applying after the start of the membership year, the single membership fee from October onwards to the end of the membership year is reduced to **£12**.
