all Committee members that the Walking Group is still open to new members and is not full.

There

are currently 92 members on the Walking Group list, but Jim points out that many of the group only

walk very occasionally and that he ensures that the number participating in any walk is limited to

ensure the safe operation of that walk. He is reluctant to remove members from the list unless they

ask to leave. I can see no reason why he should not maintain the list of current members provided

he continues to ensure that numbers on any one walk are manageable.

## STATISTICS

As of today we have 37 groups operating and 39 group leaders – several groups have more than 1  $\,$ 

group leader. In the last year seven new groups have started and one group has re-started after a

period of inactivity. Several members have stepped forward to lead the new groups and to ensure

that existing groups can continue to operate.

The total membership of all groups is 601. Obviously many members participate in more than one

group.

6 groups regularly use Abbey Row, 9 meet in members' homes, 3 use Eckford Village Hall, 2 use

Coldstream Community Centre, 10 use various venues depending on the group activity,. The following venues are each used by one of our groups: Cross Keys, Ednam Village Hall, Focus Centre at

Galashiels, Quaker Meeting House, Stitchill Village Hall, Yetholm Youth Hall.
