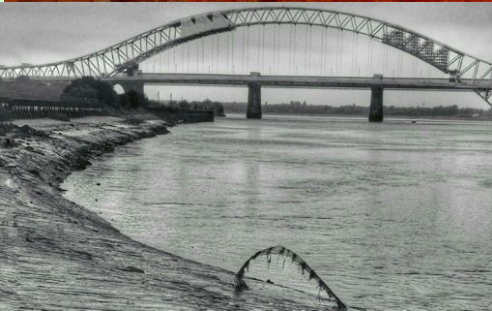
Since the last Newsletter.....
