

'Who Built Scotland: A History of the Nation in 25 Buildings', was an enjoyable and eclectic collection of contributions from Alexander McCall Smith, Alistair Moffat, James Crawford, Kathleen Jamie and James Robertson. Each described one or more place or building that interested or held some meaning for them – from prehistoric sites to recent constructions, including our very own Anniesland Court.

If seeking a systematic historical or sociological exploration of Scotland's past this is not the book for you. However, as a Historic Environment Scotland publication it delivered on its clear aim – that of raising interest in some of Scotland's treasures. We would definitely recommend dipping into this collection.
