

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY

At our February meeting we agreed that our next theme would be macro photography i.e. images of small things at greater than life size. For those members with cameras with interchangeable lenses it meant they could use their macro lens if they had one. With other cameras e.g. compact cameras. it gave the opportunity to check whether they have a macro setting and then use it. Macro can also be achieved by cropping down from a larger image. A wide range of images were viewed at our March meeting and we followed this with an outdoor macro shoot in Grange at our May meeting.
