WILLIAM ROBERT HALLAM Service No. 14520

Born in Middleton, Yorkshire in 1874 the son of Frank Hallam, a police constable, and his wife Jane.

He was the eldest son having two younger brothers and a sister.

In 1891 the family was living in London. In 1901 they lived in West Ham where William worked as a stereotyprs labourer.

At age 27 he was a batchelor living in Slough Fort, Rochester, and employed as a Bombardier in the Royal Garrison Artillery.

He died of his wounds age 35 on 3/11/1919 and is buried in Shorncliffe Military Cemetery, Cheriton, Nr Folkstone.

His parents latterly lived at Eden Mount in Grange and 8 Hazelwood Terrace, Lindale Road.

He is also commemorated on Plaistow GPO sorting Office War Memorial, London.
