There are a variety of different sized ukuleles available. The most commonly played in our group are the soprano, concert and tenor. The picture shows a soprano, tenor and baritone. The baritone is tuned differently from the other 2, it is tuned the same as the top 4 strings of the guitar. The ukulele family also includes smaller instruments as well as larger ones such as the bass ukulele.
