I.T. Advise from the June Meeting

Just a few reminders from the June Meeting on keeping the information on your computer safe:

- 1. Do not open an E-Mail from an unknown source.
- If you accidentally an E-Mail, treat it like an unwanted letter and do nothing with it, delete and / or advise that it is phishing or junk and ask for the sender to be blocked.
- 3. Use separate E-Mails for different groups.
- 4. Use strong passwords such as a random 3 words.
- 5. Use 2 step verification whenever available.
- Update everything when asked as this means someone has found a weakness.
- 7. Back up -Make sure you have that is essential to you.
 - 8. Google any suspected Scam9. Report any Phishing to

report@phishing.gov.uk

- 10. Report any suspect contacts by text to 7726
- 11. If you think that something you have done is wrong- report to Action Fraud
- 12. You can find information on u-Tube at "How private is your private information".
 - 13. Use Credit Card for on-line shopping.
- 14. Avoid Banking on-line if you can.15. Reverse image search.
 - 16. Protect your devices and Data17. Deal with any suspicious message that may be a scam.
 - 18. Look at "<u>How to stay secure</u> online cyberaware.gov <u>The</u> National Cyber Security ... for more information on the above.
