## **About the Project**

**The recording of the monumental inscriptions inside and outside the church was undertaken by members of Great Glen U3A led by Jane Moelwyn-Hughes and Toni Smith. All care has been taken to ensure accuracy of the transcription, however a visit to the church or churchyard to check with the original inscriptions is recommended.**

Words from some inscriptions were unable to be read for reasons such as broken stones, writing worn away through time etc., and so some blank spaces may occur in the transcriptions. The aim was to record the words exactly as they are found on the stone – so variations in spelling are a common occurrence.

Some of the very old graves were transcribed and published in 1798 in a book called '*The History and Antiquities of Leicestershire*' by Nichols and this can be seen at the County Record Office. Where the script was found to be unreadable, a few words may have been taken from these transcripts. Also, where the names on the monuments have been read but the date is doubtful, these have been checked with the burial registers held at The Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland Record Office, Wigston, Leicester

These recordings are also posted on the Leicestershire Villages Web Site – under the village of 'Illston'.

## **The Church of St Michael & All Saints,** **Illston, Leicestershire**

The church was originally a chapel of ease to Nosely and later Carlton Curlieu, and dates from the mid 13<sup>th</sup> century, with 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> century additions. The 18<sup>th</sup> century communion silver was given by the Hazelrigg family of Nosely.

In the late 14<sup>th</sup> century the height of the church was increased, and traces of the earlier pitch of the nave roof can still be seen above the tower arch and the added clerestory transitional doorway in the north wall, which is a common feature in medieval churches.

A fine 18<sup>th</sup> century communion table stands in the south aisle, and a typical oak chest (the parish chest) is close to the organ. The font is probably the oldest feature of the church, pre dating the existing building and is probably of Saxon origin.

The tower accommodates a ring of six bells, which are still regularly used. Three of these bells date from the 17<sup>th</sup> century,

and three commemorate the end of the Second World War. The 19<sup>th</sup> century clock in the tower is now automated. The plaque commemorating the bell ringers is elsewhere in this book.

The chancel once accommodated several pews and the organ, but has recently been reordered.

The external south wall has the remains of two primitive sundials and directly outside the porch can be found the

stump of a medieval preaching cross which is now listed as an ancient monument. There are many unusual gargoyles and water spouts.

The church has many other interesting features, many of which are documented in a leaflet available in the church for a small donation.

Issues, Revenues and profits, coming and arising from, by or out of the said Estates for and towards the mending and repairing of Highways in Ilston, otherwise Ilston aforesaid from time to time as often as necessity shall require, and for and towards the payment of the Taxes subsidies, Fifteenths and other charges wherewith the said Town of Ilston alias Illston shall at any time hereafter be lawfully charges withal to our Sovereign Lord the King his heirs and Successors.

The said Estates now consist of a Messuage in Birstall in the County of Leicester, now in the tenure of Thomas Whiles. Two Closes in Birstall aforesaid now in the tenure of the said Thomas Whiles comprising the piece plot or parcel of Land containing 26a 1r 2p or thereabouts upon the inclosure of the open fields of Birstall aforesaid in or about the year 1760 in pursuance of an act of parliament obtained for that purpose, allotted as the proportion thereof, for and in lieu of one yard Land whereof the said original Estate in the said fields consisted. A Close of Pasture in Ilston, other wise Illston, called the Town Close, containing 14 acres or thereabouts the Land heretofore of George Stavely Clerk, on the West and North, the Land heretofore of Edward Nedham on the East, and Burton Lordship on the South, now in the tenure of John Lewin.

A Close of Pasture there called Blank Close, containing 12 acres or thereabouts, now in the tenure of William Billings....

And the same by Indentures of lease and Release dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> of April 1838 were Conveyed to the use of Sir John Henry palmer Bart. Of Carlton, in the County of Northampton, the Revd Henry Palmer of Carlton Curlieu, Sir Arthur Grey Hazlerigg bart, of Nosley Geoffrey Palmer Esqr of Carlton in the County of Northampton, John King Esqr of Stretton Hall, Henry Burgess Junior of Ilston, Grazier, upon Trust, for the several uses, and purposes aforesaid.

Novr 11 1799 Mrs Catherine Palmer sister to the present Sir John Palmer Bart., gave One Hundred Pounds at 4 per cent annually to be distributed amongst the poor of Ilston.

Miss Mary Heard by Will dated July 23 1800 I Direct my Executors within twelve calendar months after my death to apply and dispose of two hundred pounds further part of my personal estates, for such Charitable purposes as they my Executors or the major part of them feel free from every Control shall think most beneficial and advantageous for the industrious and poor Inhabitants of Ilston.

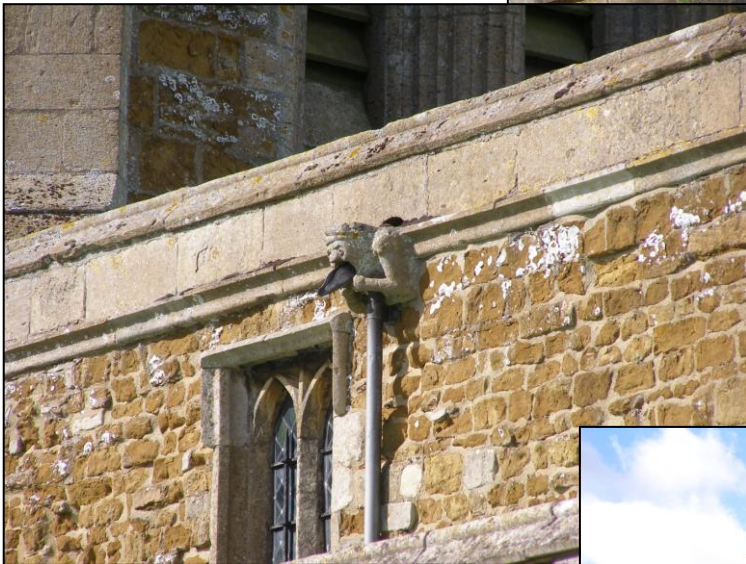

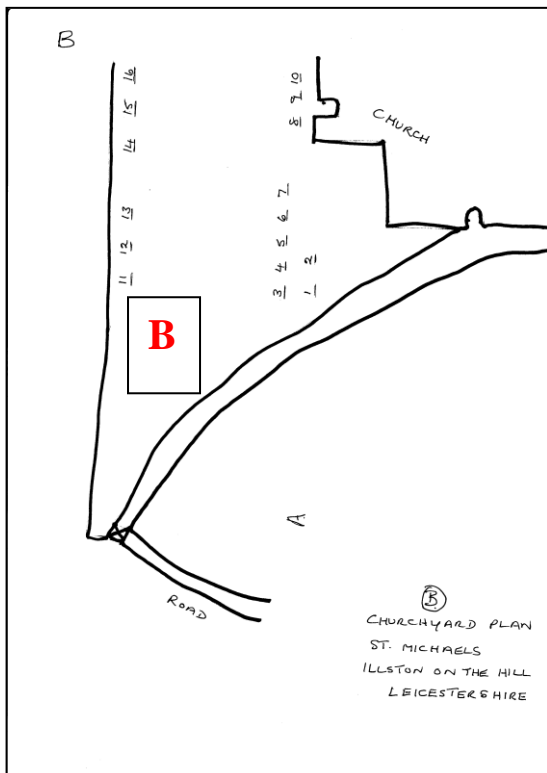


Plans of the Sections of the Churchyard

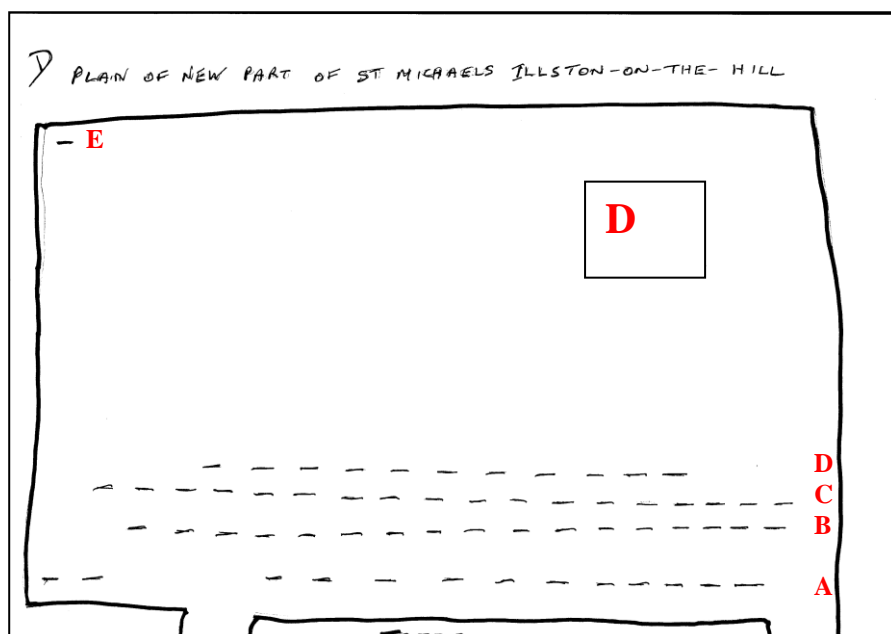
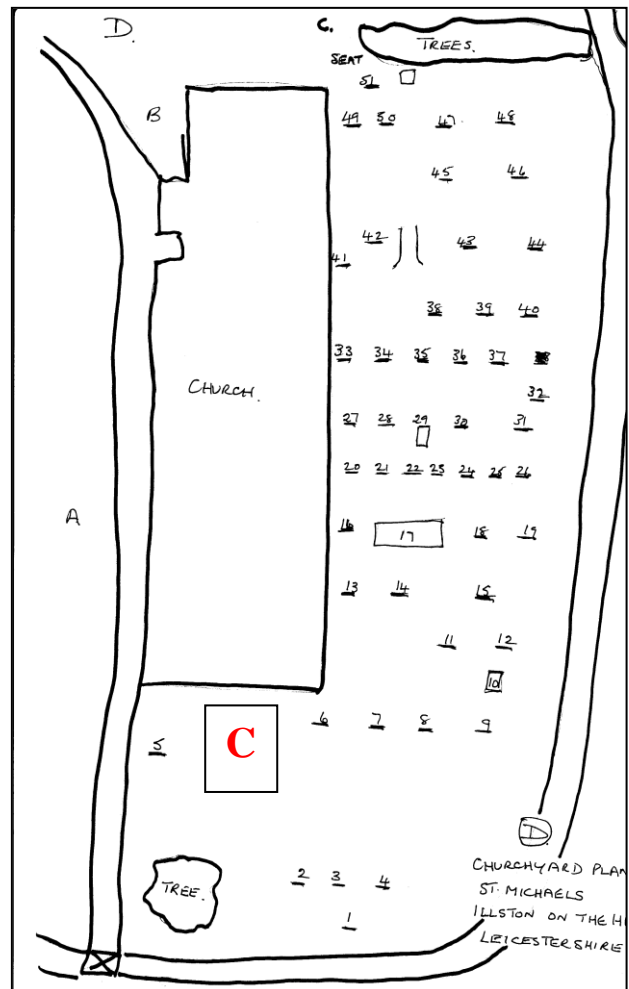

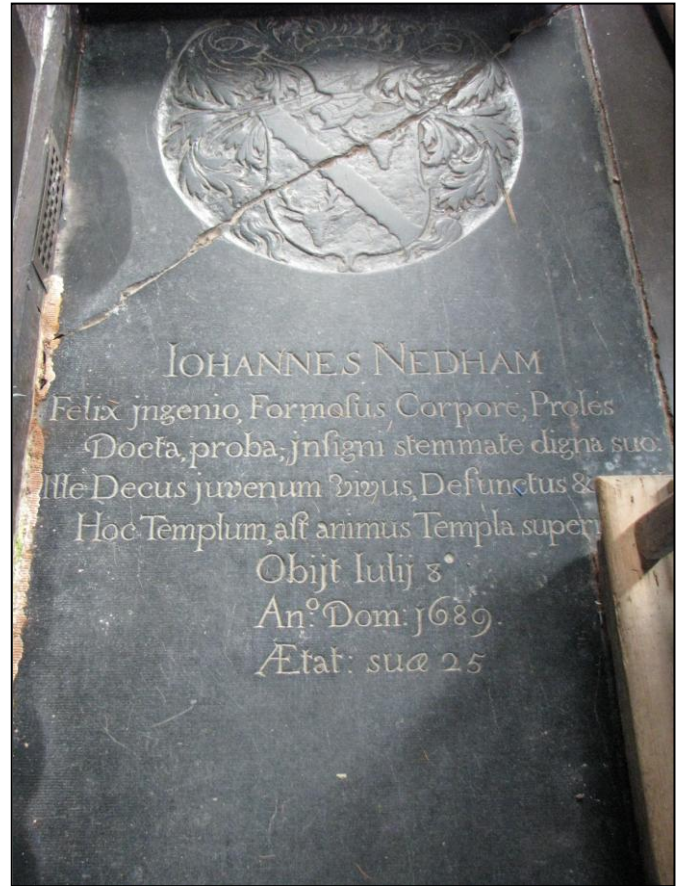
