

Church of St John the Baptist King's Norton

An early example of Georgian Gothic, the present building completed in 1775 replaced an earlier parish church. Originally built with a broach spire 156 feet high, this was destroyed in 1850 by lightening not long after repairs following a similar incident. The church was designed by J Wing, the younger, of Leicester and financed by the squire, William Fortrey, who was a bell-ringing enthusiast and he intended that the new church should be worthy of the fine bells he had commissioned.

Of the 10 bells originally hung, one came from an earlier church and the other nine were cast by Joseph Eayre of St Neots and Thomas Eayre of Kettering, between 1760 and 1764. Two bells were subsequently removed to reduce the strain on the tower. The clock and chiming mechanism are dated 1765 and inscribed Joseph Eayre.

Hanging Inside Kings Norton Church St John the Baptist

The arms on the old bell (4th) are those of the WHALLEY family, the initials being those of William Ralph. Both inside and outside the church are many monumental inscriptions to the family, who were the Lords of the Manor and Patrons of the King. A full pedigree of the Whalley family is given in "History of Gartree Hundred" by J H Hill, B.B. F.S.A. Wm Whalley had a son, Bernard, whose son Bernard dying in 1752, this lordship and that of Galby, became the property of Wm Fortrey (whose mother was Ann Whalley) and he, dying unmarried on Dec 11th 1783, was succeeded by his nephew and devisee, the Revd Hy Green M.A. of Rolleston Hall, the representative of three ancient families – GREEN, WHALLEY & FORTREY. Hy Green left the estate to the HEAP family. It was afterwards sold to PIERS ANTHONY KECK Esq., and remained in the Keck family until 1919, when it was sold to the Manchester Wholesale Co-operative Society Ltd.

Nichols, the Leicestershire historian informs us that Wm Fortrey gave a peal of 10 Bells to this church, but finding the weight dangerous, reduced them to eight. The present 4th is one of the previous ring. This Wm Fortrey was an enthusiastic admirer of Church bells, and did much to encourage improvements at different parishes in this county. He rebuilt the church of Gaulby and placed there in 1741 a peal of 6 bells. He did the same for this church as already noted. In 1738 he gave 3 trebles to St Margarets' Leicester, making them ten, and bore the greater part of the cost of rehanging them. In 1771, he gave a treble to Houghton-the-Hill, and his name is mentioned in connection with other bells in this county. Wm Fortrey died at Norton on Dec 11 1783. About three weeks before his death, as he was going into his garden before going to bed, he fell down a flight of stone steps, and not being able to recover himself, and the only servant that slept in the house having gone to bed, he lay out all night, and was found by the servant in the morning, but not quite dead. He languished however, only the short period mentioned.

Nichils says of him, "He made it his business all his life to enquire into these matters (i.e. bells and bell ringing). He was possessed of all the anecdotes that remain relating to the founder of the old bells in the steeple: St Margaret's' Leicester Hugh Walls once Mayor of Leicester) and was himself the patron and director of Thos Eayre, late of Kettering. In 1753 when John Holt published his 2broadsheet of peals", W Fortrey Esq of Galby is there shewn as a subscriber of 4 copies (see Snowden's "Grandsire")


