There are two discount codes. One for a small allocation of free tickets and one for a larger, albeit limited number of discounted tickets.

The first code is for free (100% discount) tickets and the second for half price (50% discount) tickets. And don't forget that for the Messiah, these tickets include Festive refreshments.

Try the first but if you are too late, by all means try the second. If all fails, just blow the Christmas budget and buy a regular ticket.

If the allocations go quickly and the Box Office declines to accept the codes, please email me and, while there can be no promises, I will see what can be done.

How to do it:

Highlight and copy the two discount codes for your selected concert (only the part in bold black)

100% discount code BETTY100

50% discount code BETTY50

Go through the regular online booking process by clicking HERE Choose your concert and enter the number of tickets you need Proceed to the second page but don't panic, you won't be charged at this point Enter (paste) the first - BETTY100 discount code and click on "use discount code" If that is not accepted, try the second - BETTY50 You can, of course, type in the codes but you need to get the capitalisation right. In either case, if there is still an allocation left the price will be magically reduced! But you do need to click on a delivery method – Etickets are free. And if you do decide to come to one of the concert, please tell all your chums about it – come as a group and add to the Festive Celebrations.
