Harviestoun (Scotland)	Bitter & Twisted	3.8	Tasty hoppy well balanced golden beer
Moorhouse's (Burnley, Lancs)	Pride of Pendle	4.1	Well balanced bitter
Batcombe (Somerset)	Uniion	4.8	Tasty. A bit sweet compared with the above.
Theakston	Vanilla Stout	4.5	An accurate description – a stout that tastes of vanilla, but not much else. Not exciting. Described by some as a pudding beer.
