7. Terra D'Alter Alicante Bouchet	2014	Vinho Regional Alentejano	Alicante Bouchet	14.5 %	Lea & Sandeman	Dark purple with aromas of plum and red berries. Roasted plum, chocolate tart black fruit on the palate. A rare example of this grape unblended.
8. Terra D'Alter Reserva	2014	Vinho Regional Alentejano	Trincadeira, Tinta Caiada, Aragonez, Alicante Bouchet	15.0 %	Lea & Sandeman	Ripe, soft red fruit, violets and tarry/spicy notes. A rich, complex wine with a long finish
