Brewery	Name of beer	ABV %	Tasting notes
Green Jack	Golden Bitter	3.8	Pleasant refreshingly sharpish
Crouch Vale	Neutron	3.9	Pleasant fruitiness (peach / apricot) without strong bitterness
Adnams	Southwold Bitter	3.7	Well balanced bitter served well
Nethergate	Suffolk County Best Bitter	4.0	Dark bitter with slightly smokey (toast / bacon) flavours
Adnams	Ghost Ship	4.5	Paler and more bitter than the bitter

Ownership of pubs

Purchased from Adnams, The Kings Head is now owned by eight families in the village in a consortium. Co-owner, Al, runs the pub. apparently very efficiently.

Notes about the pubs

Beers in Kings Head served by gravity from a tap room (no bar). The Kings Head, locally known as "The Low House", is an attractive historic building.
