Brewery	Name of beer	ABV %	Tasting notes
Adnams in conjunction with Northern Monk, Leeds	Sprucy Banger	4.3	A pale ale made with American hops, spruce and lemon. A dry/sharp pale ale. Good to try.
Fullers	London Pride	4.1	Well balanced tawny bitter made from English hops and crystal malt
Adnams	Southwold Bitter	3.8	A good quaffing bitter, with good hop aftertaste
Adnams	Broadside	4.7	A ruby red ale with well-balanced malty flavours
