Brewery	Name of beer	ABV %	Tasting notes
Green Dragon	Chaucer	3.7	Pleasant bitter. Malty, well hopped (Challenger hops) Popular
– ” ” –	Gold	4.4	Lighter in colour & taste. Good summer beer. Long citrus taste. (Bobek Slovenian hops)
– ” ” –	Bridge Street	4.5	Dark, malty rich flavour with pleasant bitterness (Challenger hops). Unkindly described by one member as “Old Gits’ beer”.
– ” ” –	Strong Mild	5.5	Very dark. Made with 4 different dark roasted malts and few hops. Too sweet, heavy, syrupy for most of our group.
– ” ” –	Dragon	5.5	Dark citrusy beer. Good aftertaste

Ownership and History of pub

Independently owned on a 99 year lease.
 Formerly the Horse & Groom. Became the Green Dragon brew pub in 1991 when the owners of the Green Dragon brewery purchased the premises.

Other Notes

Because the beer is brewed on site, it is cheaper than in most pubs, eg £2.80-£3.40 per pint.
 Beer can be served in four-pint jugs, which is good for a group such as ours.
