Shortts	Indie	4.8	Dark. Toast and liquorice flavours
Grain	Weizen	5.0	A lagered wheat beer in the German style. Delivered on keg but not too fizzy. Pale and cloudy. Pleasant.

Ownership and History of pub

Parts of the pub date from 1400. Interior has original C17 timber framing. The exterior is "mock Victorian" timber framing (https://www.south-norfolk.gov.uk/sites/default/files/downloads/brockdish_character_appraisal.pdf) Now a freehouse under current ownership for about four years.
