## From Marriage to The Cold War

Our February 'open to all' talk saw Toni Newbald and Toni Broad give an entertaining description of marriage in the Victorian era. This was well illustrated with a number of amusing anecdotes and local customs. We learned that economic circumstances pressured many women into marriage.

Our next 'open to all talk' will be at The Cut on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> March at 2.30 when Dr John Greenacre who lectures at the University of Suffolk will give a talk entitled 'Berlin 1944 – 1989'. He will tell us about the historical role that Berlin played in European history from 1945, throughout the cold war and until the fall of 'The Wall'. As always, there is no charge for U3A members all others are most welcome for just £3.00 on the door or in advance from the box office. The Cut Café will be open before for coffee and light lunches and time to catch up with friends.

There are now over 1000 U3As across the UK with some 440,000 members. A national recently published survey of 4,500 U3A members found that 95% of members now use the internet, and that 70% of members were female. Also, that the average age of members had increased a little to 73, perhaps not surprising with so many now retiring a little latter than in recent years. Some 59% of members volunteer for other organisations and almost 20% participate in 7 of more U3A activities each month. It is clear that many U3A members at a national level are busy people, who are involved within their local communities and it appears this is well reflected in our local membership. We continue to extend a warm welcome to new members for just £15 per year for which there is free access to our monthly talks at The Cut, and an opportunity to attend our twice-yearly social events, plus access to the 30 or so self-running interest groups many with space to welcome new members.
