Adnams	Southwold Bitter	3.8	Good bitter, served well
Green Jack	Pakefield Pride (Golden Best)	3.8	Pleasant, citrusy. Popular with the group
Wolf	Twenty 20	4.0	Copper ale. Smokey bitter flavour. A bit too bitter/sour for some. Lasting finish.
Lacons	Norfolk Gem Best Bitter	3.6	Good tasty bitter
Bull of the Woods (Waveney valley)	Winter Pale	4.2	Fruity (plum?) background flavour
