Brewery	Name of beer	ABV %	Tasting notes
Adnams	Southwold Bitter	3.7	Sometimes in the group dismissed as the standard local bitter. But after a four-month absence of it on draught it tasted wonderful. A good balanced flavour with more hoppy bitterness than many draught beers and most bottled beers.
Lacons	Encore	3.8	A paler bitter than the above with a pleasant touch of citrus flavours.
