Mileage policy

Background

Following an inquiry from a member, mileage payments, where one member offers a lift to another member(s), were discussed at the committee meeting held on 30th April 2015. The Third Age Trust recommends that each U3A should establish a policy. After consideration, the following policy was agreed. It was printed in the next newsletter and this policy is available on the Hastings & Rother U3A website.

Policy on Mileage payments when car sharing

How much another U3A member should pay a driver when being given a lift in their car to a U3A activity, essentially remains a private arrangement between the car driver and the passenger(s). Some groups may have developed their own 'rules' e.g. drivers taking turns; reciprocal lifts, etc. Where guidance is needed Hastings & Rother U3A committee recommend that the cost of the full journey be estimated at 40 pence per mile and the driver and passenger(s) share this equally. Additional costs such as parking should be included.
