Arriving at 09.45 at the kiosk in the large car park, (Satnav Reference TN31 7TX next to the Martello Tower), we will be met by Barry Yates, who will give us an exclusive 2-hour tour, with a visit to the three hides en route, including a gentle 2-mile walk. Please bring binoculars!

Rye Harbour Nature Reserve is a large coastal reserve made up of shingle beach, saline lagoons, freshwater scrapes, pools and reed beds. It is an important site for birds, plants and invertebrates; a unique landscape, rich in wildlife at all times of the year. We may see such birds as shelduck, mallard and perhaps gadwall and shoveler. Look out also for the rarer birds such as the curlew, sandpiper and little stint. After the tour you may like to visit local hostelrys or local cafes, perhaps the Bosun's Bite Café – next to the lifeboat house.
