HARROGATE SPRING FLOWER SHOW

A coach trip is being arranged to the Harrogate Spring Flower Show at the Great Yorkshire Showground on **Sunday 23rd April.** This is a very enjoyable day out, with lots to see – show gardens, talks and demonstrations, and floral displays from florists and flower arrangers from all over the country. There are several places to eat and drink. For those with mobility issues, there is fairly good accessibility, with mainly hard surfaces outside, but there is likely to be a grass surface in the marquees, which may be difficult for those with wheelchairs and wheeled walkers.

The ticket price is £21.50 per person. The cost of the coach will depend upon the number of people going but is likely to be £10-£11 per person, which includes a gratuity to the driver. The coach will leave from Ethel Ward playing field at around 9.30am and we should be back in Haxby by 5pm (times to be confirmed).
