#### 3. Upcoming Social Events (Co-ordinator - Anne Hysted)

A trip is being arranged to Brodsworth Hall House & Gardens, near Doncaster, on **THURSDAY 22**<sup>ND</sup> **JUNE.** This is an English Heritage property with lovely gardens.

"The extensive, beautiful grounds are home to a collection of grand gardens in miniature. These have been restored to their full Victorian splendour and feature a colourful array of seasonal plantings and displays.

The flower garden displays a fine selection of period bedding plants, while romantic views from the restored summerhouse take in both the formal gardens and the pleasure grounds."

Inside the Victorian country house almost everything has been left exactly as when it was still a family home and it is a fascinating museum of possessions dating back more than 130 years, from the grandest pieces of furniture to family mementoes and humble domestic items.

There is a restaurant, and a picnic area. Access is very good around the site, including in the house, where there is a lift to the first floor, but the servants' quarters can only be accessed via a staircase. Paths in the grounds are mainly tarmac.

The cost is likely to be around £26 per person including the coach fare. English Heritage members have free entry on production of a valid membership card, and will just have to pay the coach fare, which will be around £15. Travel time is about one and a quarter hours'.

The Social Team are planning a day trip in **AUGUST** but dates and bookings have not yet been confirmed. So, watch out for future announcements. Details will be available soon.

However, a date for your diary is **FRIDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER** when we hope to go to the coast, spending time in Whitby and Saltburn. The cost will be just the coach fare, again depending on numbers, but probably around £16 per person.

I know it's a long way ahead, but our last monthly meeting of the year is traditionally a Christmas party/social. This will be on **15**<sup>th</sup> **December.** The social team would very much like to hear from members with ideas for this. What would you like to do? What kind of entertainment would you like to have? Do you want refreshments to be provided? Please let me or any member of the committee have your thoughts on this.
