Pickle Ball Group

The Pickleball group will be resuming after a summer break on Thursday 6th October. It is intended to be every Thursday at 10am, in the Community Stadium, Monks' Cross.

The game is played on a badminton court, fortunately with a lower net! It is a cross between badminton, tennis and table tennis. Played as doubles, it requires movement, as opposed to running. The bats, or 'paddles' are similar to table tennis, with a slightly larger rectangular shape, hitting a hollow plastic ball (similar to those used by young children), about the size of a tennis ball. These will be provided.

We usually come changed, wearing 'comfortable' clothing, although there are changing facilities there; you will need a pair of non-marking shoes to change into on court.

We have been playing for an hour, but usually there would be the option to play longer if required, as courts are booked by the hour.
