1. Our Meeting

The 24 April meeting was well attended with 21 in the Hall, and 3 on Zoom. At the end of this report are links to our previous presentations and competitions.

2. Presentation - "Macro Photography" By Ralph

Ralph gave an excellent presentation of the very wide subject of Macro photography

The main considerations are Light, Closeness to subject, camera vibration

Ralph explained the range of equipment that can be used in Macro Photography and the type of photographs that might be taken, which involves:

- Very bright light to illuminate the subject, usually flash with diffusers
- Using Smart-phones, Bridge cameras, DSLR cameras
- Macro lenses, reverse fit the camera lens perhaps even use an enlarger lens
- Extension tubes and bellows to increase distance from lens to sensor
- Macro lens have short focal lengths so one must be very close to the subject
- A tripod is a must, as it is impossible to hand hold the camera
- An electric shutter release is required, as pressing the button vibrates camera
- The depth of field is extremely small when photographing small objects
- The depth of field can be increased by a technique called "Stacking"

Stacking involves taking many exposures of the same subject where for each exposure the focus is advanced in say .04 mm steps. There may be 70 to perhaps 7000 exposures which are then are processed by "Stacking Software". This creates a final image which is sharp and has a great depth of field.

Ralph displayed many stunning macro photographs with varied subjects other than the expected very small creatures.
