2. Presentations

2.1 Using the Cloud by Andrew

Andrew demonstrated using his mobile to take a photo of members in the hall, sending it to his Cloud storage via his lap-top, then showing how it might be edited.

2.2 Windows 11 Photo Editing by Andrew

Photo Editor is free and pre-installed on Windows 11.

--- This software has sufficient editing features for preparing most photos.

Andrew, who is a journalist for a model aircraft magazine, demonstrated how he might prepare a photo of model aircraft for publication.

- The model aircraft is suspended from a fishing rod and photographed
- A crop selects just the aircraft
- Any parts of rod or line still in the cropped photo are removed using Clone or Blur.

2.2 Windows 11 Editing using FastStone by Andrew

FastStone can be downloaded for free.

--- It has many editing features suitable for the more advance photographer

2.3 Affinity - Photo 2 - Runs on Windows and iMac

2.4 Affinity Photo-2 - Editing by Brian

Brian demonstrated Crop, Clone, Perspective and Fill

- Clone can remove unsightly elements in the photo





Some photos require **Crop** to give attractive picture "Evening Spars"





This required Perspective to correct leaning, Crop out beam and post, Clone out car





Sometimes one had to be inventive in enhancing photo Photos of a Model railway required unsightly areas to be covered with a **Fill**





To improve a photo can take a while, perhaps 15-30 minutes or even longer
