First, lan showed us a series of photos of animals in their natural environments around the world. Ian then asked us want might be unusual about these photos.

No one in the audience suggested the answer that lan gave, which was;

lan had photographed all these animals in UK wildlife parks, and with only minor edits he had removed any objects such as fences, railings or other visitors, that might suggest photo was taken in the UK.

lan gave us the following tips on photographing wildlife.

- Before going, ensure camera charged and required equipment packed.
- A mono-pod was useful to bear the weight of heavy camera and lens.
- Telephoto lenses cost about £1,000 but Tele-Convertor was about £100.
- Use Auto settings, as animals move too guickly for manual adjustments.
- Research the habits of the animals you intend to photograph, such as
 - When they were active during the day
 - Their favoured plants and places
- Wear appropriate clothing, subdued in colour to avoid scaring the animals
