2. Presentation "RAF Northolt-Night Shoot" - by Brian Hillier

On 7 March 2024 Brian Hillier and Andrew Longhurst went to RAF Northolt to photography the event called "Night Shoot", which is held in March and October every year, where a 300 photographers had paid to photograph a variety of military aircraft floodlight in the night-time sky..

The entry money was being used to complete the restoration of a 1936 fighter command room on RAF Northolt airfield, which led to the construction of the underground RAF Bunker in Vine Lane, Uxbridge.

Presented were many photographs of the 12 aircraft on display, taken by Brian Hillier and Andrew Longhurst using iphone, bridge, and DSLR cameras.

It was interesting to see photographs of the same aircraft taken with different shutter speeds, aperture and ISO settings, all of which resulted in acceptable photographs.

The main conclusion was that in this type of photography a minimum shutter speed of 1/50 or 1/100, with the appropriate aperture and ISO was required
