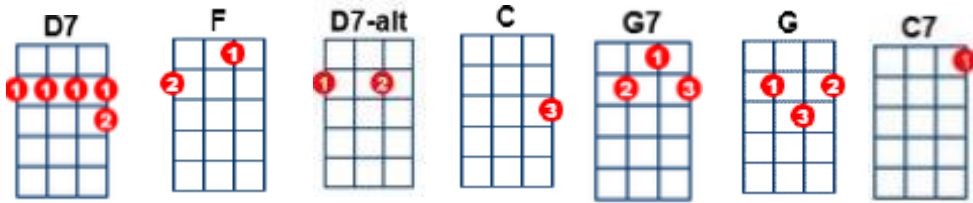


The Ballad of Davy Croquet
