## Objective

Our aim is to enable members to:

- Improve their photography and increase confidence in taking photographs.

## Meetings – Where, When and How Much Does It Cost?

- Meetings are once a month, all year round.
- Second Wednesday of Each Month, 10.00 to 12.00, Wesley Room, Methodist Church.
- Meetings will last 2 hours, including a tea/coffee break.
- We will have occasional, additional local outings.
- There will be a charge of £3.00 for each meeting, which will include tea/coffee.

## What Will the Group Do

- To start the meeting, you will be encouraged to show 5-10 of your photos on a theme set at the previous meeting. We will discuss them as a group and offer advice. For the first meeting the theme is “Open” – any subject you want. Please bring photos on a USB memory stick.
- The second part of the meeting will involve some simple improvements that can be made to photos with a computer, then allow time for you to ask specific questions about your camera, computers, or photography in general.
- We will have occasional “visiting speakers” - and focus on specific topics (eg “landscape”, “people”).
- From time to time we will arrange local outings.

## What Do You Need?

- **You need** – Something that takes photos – a camera or smart-phone. You don't need a big, black, expensive camera!
- **You don't need a computer to join the group** - it is possible to produce good photos straight out of the camera or smart-phone. **But!** the photos will often benefit from further work. This involves basic software, and it may be possible on a smart-phone, or can be done on a computer. We will introduce this at meetings and develop it as the Group wants.
