Meets: Third Tuesday afternoon each month Venue: Minster Library Time: 2.15pm Cost: Donations for tea & biscuit




This popular group like to try a variety of book genres and Val arranges for Minster Library to provide the enough books for the group to read. The group discuss the book the following month.
