SAT 22 APRIL 1-5pm: Wateringbury, Maidstone – medium sized garden containing a mixture of flowers, shrubs, fruit and vegetables. It provides pollinators with a food source all year round and along with an established pond, provides water and habitats for a wide range of wildlife including birds, mammals, amphibians, reptiles and insects

SUN 14 MAY 1-5pm: Minster, Sheppey – coastal garden with stunning sea views, planting designed to be attractive to people and wildlife all year round

SUN 4 JUN 1.5pm: Sittingbourne - Bringing back the buzz in a mature family garden

SUN 11 JUN 1-5pm: Gravesend - A tranquil haven for people and wildlife with an abundance of flowers for bees and butterflies and 3 ponds. Featured on BBC Gardeners' World Sept 2022

SAT 17 JUN 1-5pm: Edenbridge-Riverside Garden with borders, mini-meadow and ponds. Winner of Sevenoaks in Bloom pollinator-friendly garden and Edenbridge wildlife garden 2022

SAT 24 JUN 1-5pm: Grafty Green – large country garden with wide range of habitats, including a meadow with a mass of different wildflowers attracting a variety of pollinators

SUN 25 JUN 1-5pm: Selling, Faversham – artist's garden bordered by rose hedges in a rural setting, enhanced by natural wood and fused glass features
