



During your visit to our Dairy Farm

We are delighted to show you what goes on behind the scenes on our family run working dairy farm at Somerby near Melton Mowbray.

- * Watch & learn how the Cows are milked
- * Help feed all the baby calves some milk
- * Tractor & Trailer Ride around the fields
- * Afternoon Tea & Cakes refreshments included
- * Taste and buy Blue Stilton, Shropshire Blue and Rutland Red cheese

 Learn about how we produce milk from our 300 herd of Ayrshire & Friesian cows
 who spend their days grazing our fields. Watch and learn about how we milk 48
 cows at a time through the milking parlour and help feed our week old baby
 calves. As Sept is the height of our block calving season, there may well be a chance
 to watch a cow calving if you're lucky! And you don't have to wear wellies!
