Equipment and Resources

- Electrical equipment in public buildings has to be tested. Your personal equipment may be used by yourself without complying with PAT. Equipment owned by the U3A may be used by U3A members without being tested.
- A list of the technical resources owned by Ledbury & District U3A is available from the Groups Coordinator. Help may be arranged for using this equipment.
- Usually groups should be self-funding. However, if you need equipment or resources of a lasting nature for your group, speak to a committee member, as funds may be made available. Assets purchased from general funds remain the property of Ledbury & District U3A and should be labelled as such.
- The national U3A website is a valuable starting point for advice and information. Go to http://www,u3a,org.uk/ then click on "Learn" and then "Subject advice".
