

Visit to Llandegley Rocks 5th September 2018. Led by Dr Joe Botting

Dr Joe Botting led members on a visit to Llandegley rocks part of the Builth inlier. His handout explains that 'the exposed geological succession of Llandegley Rocks is one of the key areas for understanding the history of the Builth Inlier, as well as including a unique Konservat-Lagerstätte that reveals an otherwise unknown type of shallow marine community. Although it only includes a relatively small part of the total sequence, it shows the initial formation and beginnings of the erosion of the main volcanic island.'
