- Reporting

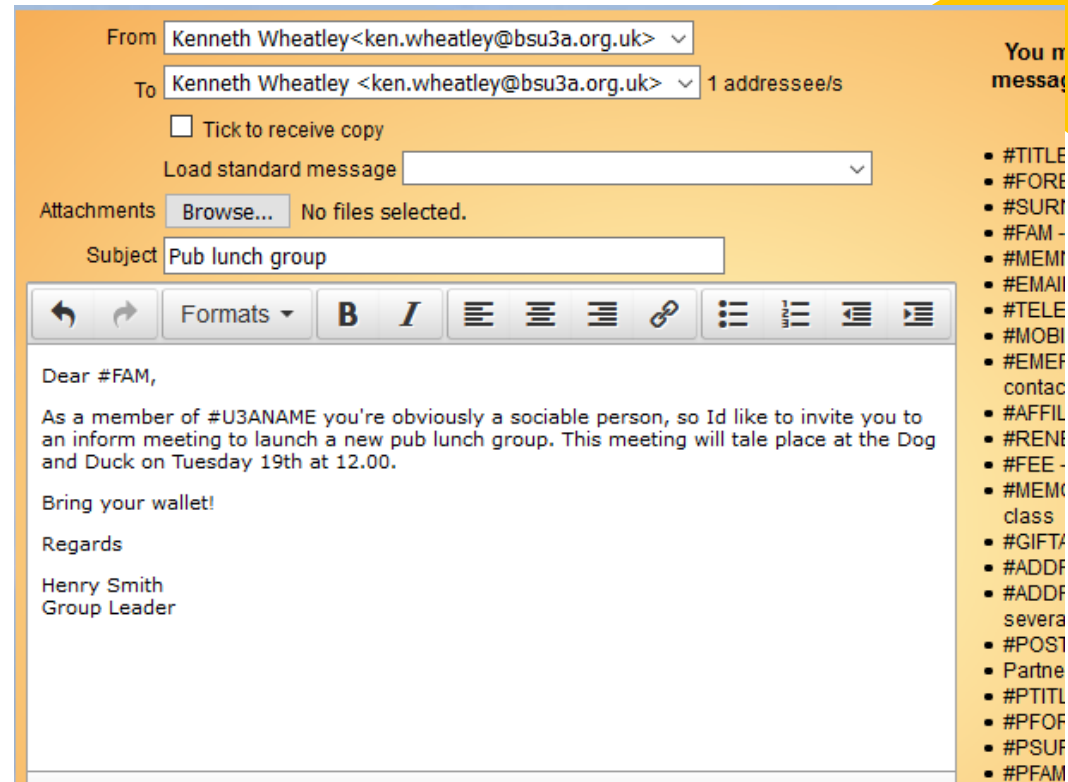
Attracting and Retaining Members

- Reducing Membership Management time
- People can join online
- Members can renew online
- Greatly improved communications



Communication with Members

- Email all or some members
- Contact members of a group
- Members can see groups, calendar, their status in Member Portal



Keeping data secure and accurate

- Data is in one, secure, place
- Strong controls on who can access or alter data
- Beacon is a great aid in ensuring GDPR compliance



Turnover of officers

- Common online platform used by hundreds of u3as
- Accessible from anywhere and any device
- Easy to learn
- Roles can be shared, easing handover



Reporting

- Generate reports for
 - AGM
 - Auditor
 - Charities Commission
 - HMRC (GiftAid)
 - Committee

- To provide one page login to all Members, Users and Editors
- To incorporate Events management and Financial package upgrade
- To develop a package for networks and regions to communicate directly with u3as and members.
