"Travelling Plants" invites volunteers from u3a to take part in a collaborative project to transcribe, research and encode the first of Kew Gardens' *Register Books* (1793-1809), funded by The National Archives. Volunteers will work with staff from Kew Gardens and the University of Roehampton to create a digital edition of a key source for the history of botany in Britain. We welcome volunteers with interests in botany, gardening, history, exploration, computer coding and/or editing, but we don't require any particular expertise - just a desire and willingness to learn along with us. We will provide training in all aspects of the project via online seminars and tutorials beginning in February 2021. We will be on hand to support you throughout the project period, which concludes in December 2021 with a launch of the digital edition at Kew Gardens.
