

Member code of conduct

Purpose

The member code of conduct clarifies the standard of behaviour expected from each member.

Code

- 1) Members are expected to know, follow and promote the Principles of the u3a movement.
- 2) Members must always act in the best interests of Longridge u3a and the u3a movement, strive to uphold its reputation and never do anything which could bring their own, Longridge u3a, another u3a or the u3a movement into disrepute or expose it to undue risk.
- 3) Members are expected to use Longridge u3a's resources responsibly and only to further its stated charitable objects and purposes.
- 4) Members are expected to reflect the current organisational policy of Longridge u3a, regardless of whether it conflicts with their personal views.
- 5) Members are expected to abide by Longridge u3a's procedures and policies.
- 6) Members are expected to treat each other with dignity and respect at all times.
