Joy Dyson speaking about **Chailey Heritage**, a special school for children with neurodisabilities, high health needs and associated learning difficulties.

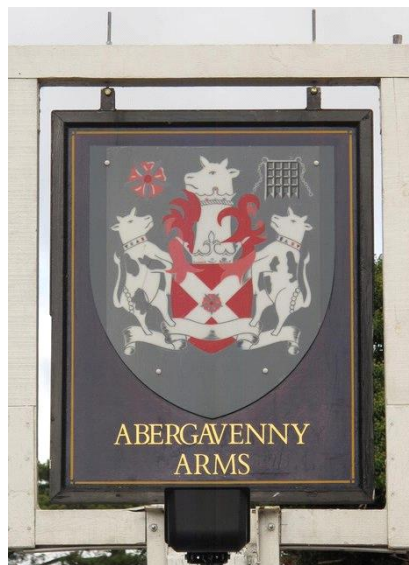
Friday 21 October
