Meetings normally take place between 2 and 4 pm on the 3rd Monday of every month. Weather permitting, we go on "field trips" to practice our photography at a variety of agreed photogenic locations. If this isn't possible we meet in a member's home to review each other's photos from previous outings and to improve our photographic knowledge.

If you would like to know more about photography, how to use the controls on your camera, how to take better pictures, how to use your computer to make the most of your digital photos and how best to share and display your work, this Group has a lot to offer you.

Bring your camera along, regardless of make or model, for help on how to use aperture and shutter priority modes, manual mode, histograms and exposure compensation. Receive guidance on how to change other settings such as file type, resolution, white balance and ISO.

Familiarise yourself with the three basic elements of exposure : aperture, shutter speed and ISO, what they are, what they do and how the values you choose affect the photos you take.

Learn how to improve your compositions, transfer and manage digital files, enhance your photos using basic image manipulation, create audio-visual slideshows, print, mount and share photographs.
