

## Notice from the Theatre and Outings Teams

Please help us by putting all cash and cheque payments to us in a sealed envelope with your name on and details of what you are paying for. This helps us to process your payment accurately and efficiently.

### **Residues from Events**

It is the intention of this u3a that all events (e.g. outings, theatre visits, meals.) be planned to cover their own costs. We do not set out to raise funds from these activities. This is the same principle as applies to Group activities. However, we must not make a loss on either.

To ensure that unexpected losses do not occur it has been agreed that refunds will not normally be made if someone cannot attend whatever the reason.

The expectation is that they will find a replacement. We offer help in finding a replacement. The one exception to this is where a cost has not been incurred (e.g. an entrance fee) the monies for that part of the initial charge will be refunded.

Due to the popularity of some events, the monies collected are greater than expected or unexpected economies of scale are made due to the use of a larger coach. This leaves a surplus.

The u3a Committee has agreed the following policy to cover what we will do if there is a surplus.

- If the likely refund per person is £10 or more, then individual refunds will be made.
- If the likely refund per person is less than £10, then the surplus will be used to reduce the cost of future similar events including any losses incurred on similar events.
